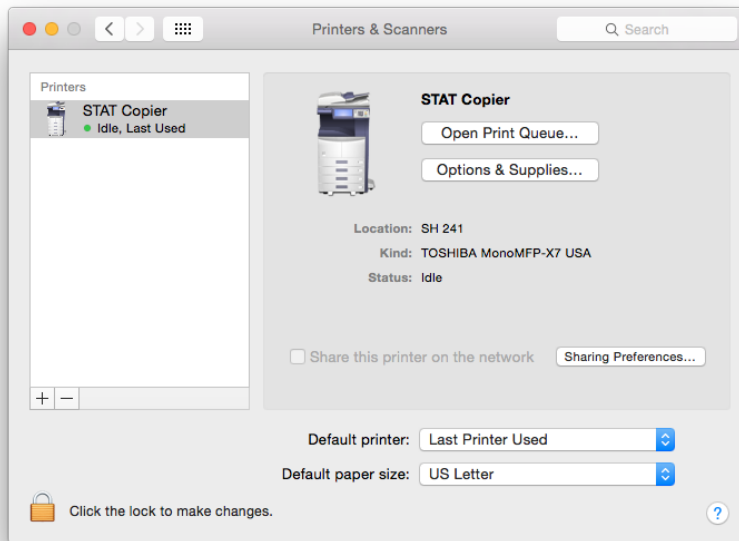
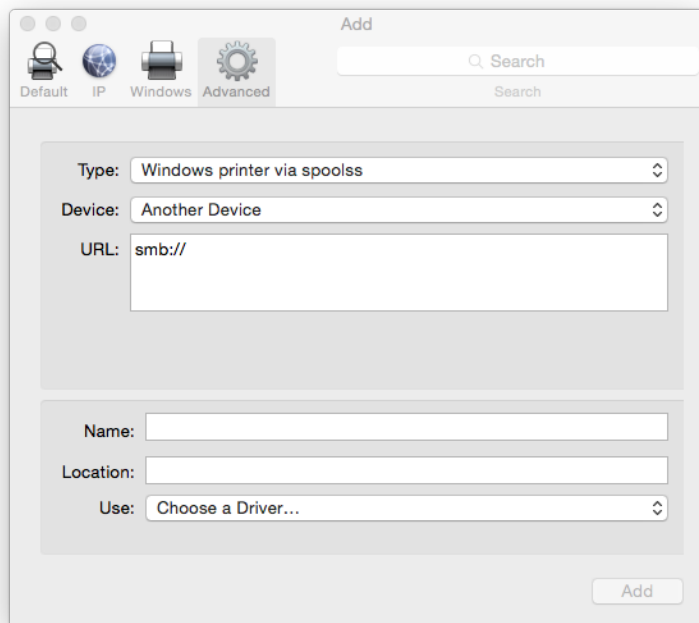


To set up printing on a Mac as of 3/4/2015

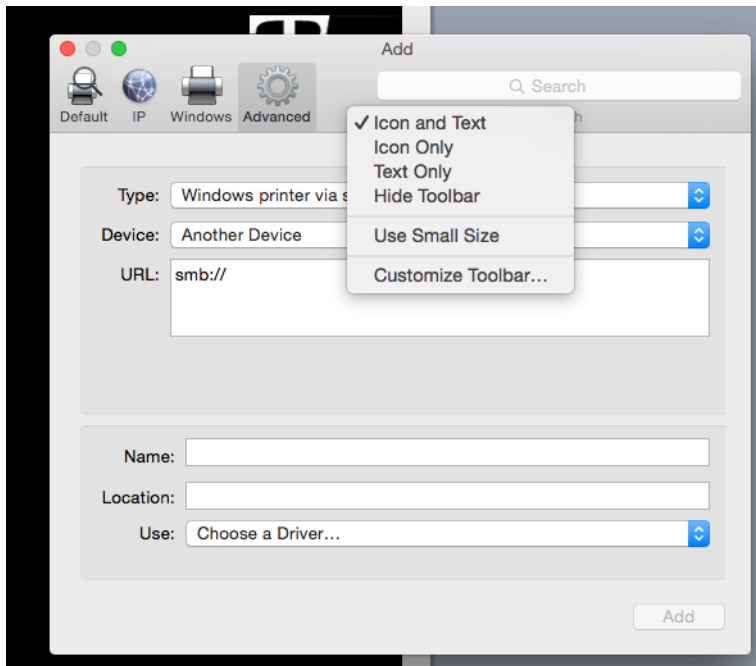
First, go into System Preferences and open Printers & Scanners



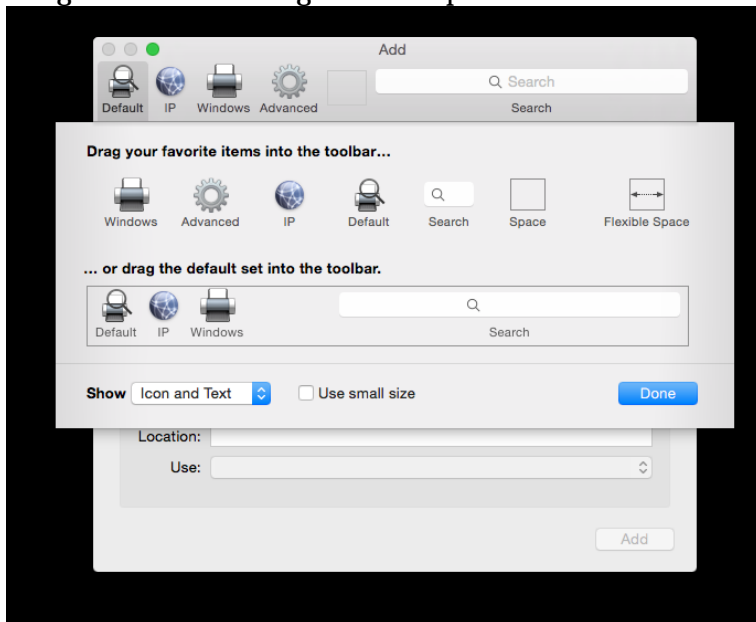
Click the + symbol to add a new printer.



If the “Advanced” dialog box isn’t displayed, Control-click the white space and select Customize Toolbar...



Drag the “Advanced” gear icon up into the toolbar.



Select Advanced.

In the Type: pull-down menu, select Windows printer via spools

In the URL: field, type:

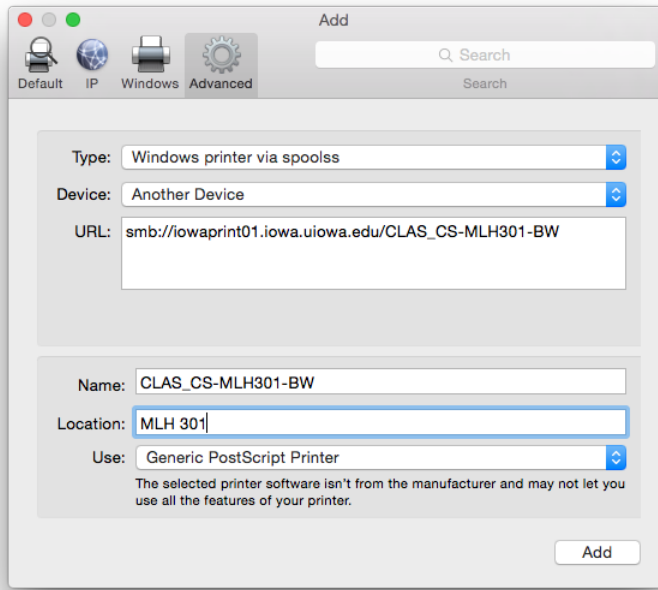
smb://iowaprint01.iowa.uiowa.edu/<queuenam>,

where <queuenam> is the name of the printer you wish to connect to, such as CLAS_CS-MLH301-BW

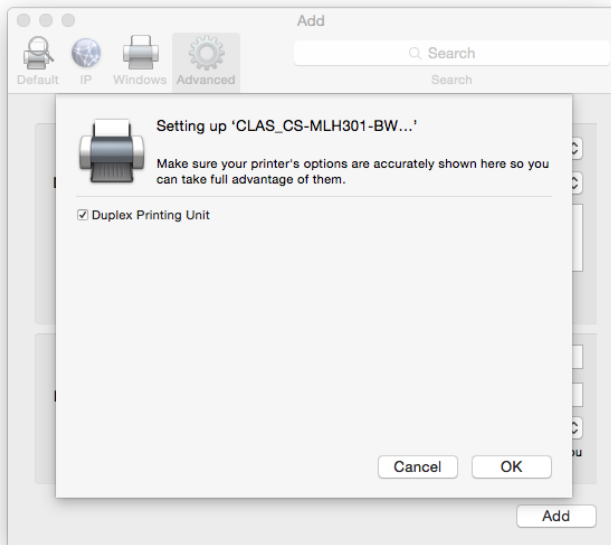
In the Name: field, type the printer name again.

In the Location: field, type the room number where the printer is located.

Under the Use: pull-down menu, select Generic PostScript Printer. Or download the correct driver from HP.



Then click the Add button



When prompted, check the box for Duplex Printing Unit, then click OK

After the print setup completes, double-click the printer to open it. Then select the Printer menu, and then select "Print Test Page" to verify that everything is working correctly.
